SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1 WRITE A DISSERTATION OR RESEARCH PAPER THAT

- Has a specific research question.
- Applies an original perspective to existing material, contributes empirical findings, or proposes new conclusions.
- Is **POLITICAL** in the broadest sense: as relates to the institutions, systems, or practices of power or rule, both within and beyond the traditional boundaries of political science.
- Is **UNDERGRADUATE** work.

2 EDIT YOUR PAPER

- Cut to 6000 words max, with notes, excluding bibliography.
- Format according to our style guide.

3 SEND TO LSEUPR @LSE.AC.UK AND AWAIT REVIEW

- Email subject should follow this format: "LSEUPR Journal Submission, [name], [institution]". Please email us from your university email if possible.

4 WORK ON YOUR PAPER WITH EDITORS

- Papers are accepted or rejected based on the academic quality of their content, clarity of argument, and originality of thought.
- Pending selection by our editors, your paper will be reviewed by LSE academics.

5 CREATE A SHORT BLOG PIECE ON YOUR RESEARCH PROCESS
